Rainer – Key Facts

- A national organisation running 55 services with the capability to deliver services throughout the UK.
- An annual expenditure in 05/06 of £21.6million.
- Over 650 staff and 550 volunteers.
- 16,500 young people and young adults worked with last year – 70% over 16, 70% male, 70% white.
- 97% spent on direct delivery and new initiatives.
- 74% of income from contracts with statutory bodies.

Rainer Z-Bikes

- Started 2004
- Run in partnership with Uttlesford District Council
- Uttlesford Residents currently
- 16 – 18 years
- Actively seeking or in Education, Employment or Training
- Have an unreasonable journey time or complexity
- Have no access to public transport
- Hold a current driving license, this may be provisional

Facts and Figures

- We own 16 Bikes,
- *14 on loan*
- *1 Curtsey bike*
- *1 Donor Bike*
- Each Young Person must
- *Undertake full training*
- *Be fitted for helmet and protective clothing*
- *Make regular payments of £20.00 per month*
- *Take bike for monthly checks by local garage,*
- *6 Monthly Service for bikes*
- *Pay for petrol, oil and light bulbs*
- *Be responsible for the security and roadworthiness of the bike*
